Olsen began his judicial service in January 2007 when he was elected as Associate District Judge, Seminole County. He then served as District Judge of the 22nd Judicial District for six years.

He handled civil cases across nearly all areas of the law, including complex oil and gas matters, business litigation, contract disputes, landowner disputes, insurance bad faith, construction litigation, inverse condemnation, personal injury and open meeting act violations.
